## Conquest of Europe: Luv' on the Europarade

The **Europarade** was the first reliable barometer of the hit singles success in Europe as it was based on national singles charts. It was aired in May 1976 on Dutch TROS radio station until 1983 and published in Billboard Benelux magazine. Initially, the charts of six countries were combined into the Europarade: Belgium (BRT Top 30), France (Hitparade RTL), Germany (Musik-Informationen/Aktuelle 50). Netherlands (Nationale Hitparade), Spain (Radio Madrid/Superventas 30) and the UK (BBC Radio 1/British Top 50). In 1979, Denmark, Italy, Austria and Switzerland were added followed by Ireland in 1983. Because Luv' conquered a large part of Continental Europe, the girls scored several singles on this chart like the Top 5 hits U.O.Me, You're the Greatest Lover, Trojan Horse, Casanova and Ooh, Yes I Do. The peak positions of these singles are mentioned in the "Charts" page of the site. It has been hard to find infos about the "chart of the charts" for a long time on internet. Fortunately a fan posted the entire **Europarade** on the forum of the ukmix.org site
